***** IMPORTANT *****

-Typing error in the paper CRF's-

Please note Inspiratory Capacity (IC) is not part of the DLCO measurement as the paper CRF suggests. Please record IC in Litres.

-Unsubmitted Cases-

We have too many cases pending submission. We urgently need these to be completed and submitted to the registry. Please contact the study coordinator if you require assistance on submitting cases or if cases need to be deleted from your account.

-UK Centre Accruals-

Cases must be fully completed and submitted to the registry in order to be accounted for in the accruals submission at the end of each month. Cases which remain in the "unsubmitted" section cannot be included until fully submitted.

-Review Data-

Only NEW information should be entered in the review forms. Please do not enter data which has been captured at previous visits.

Reminders for case review will be emailed to all team members at 9months and an amber exclamation mark will be displayed on the eCRF. This icon will turn red at 12months to show the case is expected.
